



## HLTAID009 & UETDRMP007 Combo (CPR & Perform rescue from a live LV panel)

### Course Content

*UETDRMP007 Perform rescue from a live low voltage panel* (commonly referred to as "LVR" for "Low Voltage Rescue") covers the performance of rescue procedures from live low voltage apparatus, not including overhead lines and underground cables in the workplace and includes CPR

### Learning Objectives

In the course you will learn how to:

- **Master the DRSABCD Action Plan:** Learn the critical steps for emergency response.
- **Recovery Techniques:** Discover effective recovery positions and improvisation methods.
- **CPR Proficiency:** Perform CPR as a single rescuer and in team rotations.
- **Emergency Response:** Handle regurgitation or vomiting with confidence.
- **Practical Experience:** Practice on adult (floor) and infant (firm surface) manikins.
- **AED Operation:** Operate an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) with ease.
- **Incident Management:** Communicate effectively with emergency services, participate in debriefs, and complete incident reports.
- **Apply WHS/OHS Processes:** Implement safety measures to control risks effectively.
- **Maintain Rescue Equipment:** Keep your live panel rescue kit in optimal condition.
- **Safe Rescue Operations:** Remove a casualty from a live low voltage panel safely.
- **First Aid Skills:** Treat burns and bleeding injuries promptly.
- **Incident Management:** Secure the incident scene efficiently.

### Prerequisites

The specific course entry requirements are to have either

UEECD0007 Apply work health and safety regulations, codes and practices in the workplace

**or**

UETDREL006 Work safely in the vicinity of live electrical apparatus as a non-electrical worker

and

the successful completion of *HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation* (commonly referred to as "CPR"). The LVR course is delivered with CPR, enrolling in LVR automatically enrolls you in CPR and you will complete both units during the training.

### Physical ability

To successfully complete this course, you must be physically able to complete the assessments which include:

- Performing uninterrupted CPR for at least two minutes on an adult resuscitation manikin placed *on the floor*
- Performing uninterrupted CPR for at least two minutes on an infant resuscitation manikin (firm surface)
- Demonstrating safe manual handling techniques.

**Certificate(s) Issued:**

A Statement of Attainment for *HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation* and *UETDRMP007 Perform rescue from a live low voltage panel*.

**Certificate Validity:**

- CPR and LVR are valid for 12 months and must be completed every 12 months for anyone working on Delivery Mode(s):
